Objections to second proposed electoral boundary changes now online

The 2019 NT Electoral Boundary Redistribution Committee has received seven submissions to its second proposed changes to the NT Legislative Assembly's electoral boundaries.

The submissions are now available for public viewing on the NT Electoral Commission's website.

The NT Legislative Assembly's electoral boundaries are being redrawn in preparation for the 22 August 2020 election.

The Redistribution Committee published its first proposed redistribution of the Territory into 25 electorates on 13 May 2019 and invited objections to the proposals by 14 June 2019.

The second proposed redistribution was published on 31 July 2019 and invited objections to the proposals by 14 August 2019.

The committee's second redistribution proposed that:

- The rural Katherine suburb of Venn and Tindal RAAF base move to the division of Arnhem.
- The division of Fong Lim gain electors from Coonawarra and a portion of Berrimah.
- The division of Karama gains a portion of Berrimah electors.
- The division of Nelson remains the same as it was for the 2016 Territory election.
- The new name for the division of Stuart be revised from Gwoya to Gwoja

The Redistribution Committee will consider the objections to determine if further changes to the Territory's electoral boundaries are required before the final report is published.
