POSTAL VOTING

Ballot papers are on their way to a total of 958 Palmerston electors who applied for a postal vote.

The mail out of ballot material ceases at 6pm on:

- Tue, 13 Mar – to forwarding addresses overseas
- Thu, 15 Mar – to forwarding addresses in Australia



EARLY VOTING CENTRE



The voting centre at Palmerston Shopping Centre has proven popular for residents choosing to vote early.

To date, a total of 2,134 Palmerston electors have voted.

Early voting centres are open until Friday 16 March with the Palmerston Shopping Centre location open this **Saturday from 9am until 5pm.**

SCRUTINEER APPOINTMENT

To appoint a scrutineer at a voting centre, the [scrutineer appointment form](#) must be completed and presented to the officer-in-charge on arrival.

NOTE:

- There is one scrutineer per candidate permitted inside the voting centre during voting hours. They must remove any campaign material including branded t-shirts when scrutineering.
