1. Election night counts

Election day voting centres

At the conclusion of voting at 6:00 pm, a first preference count of ordinary ballot papers will be conducted. After the first preference count is completed a notional distribution of preferences, two candidate preferred count (TCP) will be conducted.

Candidates may appoint scrutineers to represent them for these counts. For all election day voting centres, one scrutineer is allowed per candidate per count table and there will be two count tables in operation. This means that each candidate is entitled to have a maximum of two scrutineers at each election day voting centre. Scrutineers are to ensure they are at the voting centre no later than 5:45 pm.

Election night scrutiny centres (early, postal & remote)

A first preference count of early, postal and remote votes will be conducted from 6:00 pm in the scrutiny centres in Darwin and Alice Springs. After the first preference count, a notional distribution of preferences to the two selected candidates (TCP) will be conducted.

Candidates may appoint scrutineers to represent them in these centres. One scrutineer is allowed per candidate per count table. In these centres one count table will be in operation per division. Scrutineers are to ensure they are at the scrutiny centre no later than 5:45 pm.

Scrutineers can be appointed to more than one division but require a scrutiny appointment form to be signed by each relevant candidate. The [scrutineer appointment form](#) is available on the election website
