### **Final NT electoral boundaries released**

The 2019 NT Electoral Boundary Redistribution Committee has released its final boundaries of the Northern Territory divisions for the Legislative Assembly.

The NT Legislative Assembly's electoral boundaries have been redrawn in preparation for the 22 August 2020 election.

"The Redistribution Committee has finished an extensive process of consultations and considerations to finalise the Northern Territory's 25 electoral division boundaries for the Legislative Assembly," NT Electoral Commissioner, Mr Iain Loganathan said today.

"I wish to thank all the organisations and people who took the time to offer submissions to the committee to help them with their determinations."

The main changes to the boundaries for the 2020 election affect the divisions of Katherine, Stuart and Namatjira.

The division of Stuart also has a new name. It will be called Gwoja, following a suggestion offered to the redistribution committee.

The division of Nhulunbuy has also been renamed, it will be known as Mulka for the 2020 Territory election.
