Barkly has 6,238 enrolled electors as at 1 May 2024.

Observations

The final margin for the electorate of Barkly was 5 votes with the CLP candidate elected at the 2020 Territory Election. All counts for the electorate of Barkly were conducted at the Alice Springs scrutiny centre.

The ALP candidate was leading until the final count of postal and declaration votes on Friday 4 September.

Location

The electorate of Barkly occupies the eastern half of the interior of the Northern Territory. It extends from just south of the Sandover Highway in the south, to just north of the Carpentaria Highway in the north.

The electorate includes the Barkly Tableland, the regional centre of Tennant Creek and the communities of Ali Curung, Alpurrurulam, Ampilatwatja, Arlparra, Borroloola, Daly Waters, Elliott, Larrimah, and Ti Tree.
