POST ELECTION DAY COUNTING

Recheck

A recheck of all votes counted on Saturday night will be conducted from 9am Monday 26 March at level 3, TCG Centre, 80 Mitchell St Darwin.

Scrutineers must produce a completed [scrutineer appointment form](#) upon arrival at the count centre.

Counts will be conducted using Easy Count, a computerised vote counting software application. Easy Count is a system that requires input of each ballot paper twice by two different data entry operators.

The results of first preference counts conducted on Saturday night are available on the results page at ntec.nt.gov.au.

Postal votes

Over 730 postal votes have been returned and accepted. A first preference count of all returned and accepted postal ballot papers will be conducted on Tuesday 27 March from 9am and results will be published to the NTEC website upon completion. The recheck of postal ballot papers will then be conducted using Easy Count.

The deadline for receipt of postal ballot papers is **12:00 noon Tuesday 3 April**.

After the deadline, remaining postal votes will be counted, the quota for all ballot papers determined and the distribution of preferences conducted.
