Additional Submission

After reviewing the submissions online I realised I had inadvertently left out two SA1 Statistical Areas from my submission dated 22 March 2019.

I have corrected this error by moving two SA1s (7101207 & 7102208) from Spillett to Karama. This has the effect of slightly increasing the projected enrolments in Karama and slightly decreasing those in Spillett.

I note this suggestion is consistent with the Territory Labor submission for Karama, although I also note the Territory Labor submission fails to allocate the RAAF Darwin (7100608), The Narrows (7100607), Winnellie (7100906) and Charles Darwin Nation Park (7101501) to any electorate.

I have also attached to this additional submission a copy of the copy of the map [Boundaries of Electoral Divisions 2015 \(sheet 3 of 6\)](#) showing the suggested boundary changes to the divisions of Fong Lim, Karama, Sanderson and Spillett.

The following tables show the suggested changes from my original submission together with the additional changes (**bold**):

1. Move the following SA1 statistical areas from Spillett to Sanderson:

2. Move the following SA1 Statistical Areas from Spillett to Fong Lim:

3. Move the following SA1 Statistical Areas from Spillett to Karama:

7102208	5	5	McMillians Road Marrara

With regard to projected enrolment numbers, the above changes would have the following effects:


1. Spillett – projected enrolment (Aug 2020) of **5,971**, or **6.54%** above quota;
2. Fong Lim – would remain as previously stated with a projected enrolment of **5,776**, or **3.06%** above quota;
3. Sanderson – projected enrolment of **5,800**, or **3.49%** above quota; and
4. Karama – projected enrolment of **5,407**, or **-3.53%**.

The additional changes take into consideration the section, currently in the division of Spillett, which runs from the Stuart Highway up Amy Johnson Avenue to McMillans Road, then along to Vanderlin Drive and down Vanderlin Drive to the Stuart Highway at Berrimah, then back along the Stuart Highway to Amy Johnson Avenue. It does not make sense to include this section in the suggested redrawn Spillett.

On these suggested boundaries Spillett retains the Defence Establishment Berrimah, formerly HMAS Coonawarra (**DEB**). While DEB is isolated to some degree from the remainder of Spillett it will have a strong community of interest with the developing suburb of Northcrest.

I ask that these submissions be read and considered in conjunction with my original submissions.
