1. Scrutineer briefing sessions

Scrutineer briefing sessions will be conducted in the Alice Springs and Darwin scrutiny centres. Scrutineers should therefore arrive by **5:30 pm**, with their completed [scrutineer appointment forms](#). If conducting scrutines for more than one division, a completed form is required for **each** relevant division. On arrival, a NTEC staff member will register each scrutineer's attendance, and issue them with a vest and name tag. The scrutineer briefing session will take place at 5:45 pm prior to the commencement of the count. As the scrutiny centres are secure areas, **doors will be locked from 6:00 pm**.

2. Election night count

Counting will begin as soon as possible after voting centres close at 6.00 pm on Saturday 27 August 2016. All votes taken on election day will be counted at that venue from 6:00 pm.

Early votes, including postal votes and votes taken by remote voting teams will be counted at central scrutiny centres located in Darwin and Alice Springs.

Some remote voting teams will be counted at voting centres in Alyangula, Borroloola, Galiwinku, Nhulunbuy, Wadeye and Wurrumiyanga (Nguuiu).

Scrutineers are permitted to attend voting centres and/or scrutiny centres to observe the count, as long as they have a completed [scrutineer appointment form](#). Candidates are entitled to have one scrutineer at each counting table. Election day voting centres will have two counting tables operating.

3. Sunday – no counting

There won't be any counting conducted on Sunday 28 August as all votes on hand are counted on Saturday night. The declaration vote exchange between Darwin and Alice Springs votes will be conducted on Sunday and counting will resume on Monday 29 August. A newsletter will be issued on Sunday, outlining the count order for Monday.

4. Missing campaign signage

The NTEC has received numerous reports of campaign signage being removed or stolen. If you are aware of any signs that have been removed, please ensure that they are returned to the relevant candidate/party.

Candidates and campaign workers are reminded to respect each other and conduct themselves appropriately on election day.

7. Postal votes

All postal votes returned to date will be counted on Saturday night. Postal votes received after Saturday will be admitted to counts next week.

Voters must complete and send their postal voting papers before 6:00 pm on Saturday 27 August and they must be received by 12:00 noon on Friday 9 September. This allows time for interstate, overseas and remote postal votes to be returned and included in the count.
