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Declaration

I declare that I am qualified under Part III, Division 2 of the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* to be a candidate for election as a member of the Legislative Assembly as I:

- am an Australian citizen;
- have reached the age of 18 years;
- am entitled, or am qualified to become entitled, to vote at elections of members of the Legislative Assembly; and
- have resided within the Commonwealth for at least six months and within the Territory for at least three months.

I also declare that I:

- do not hold an office or appointment (other than a prescribed office or appointment) under a law of the Commonwealth or a law of a State or Territory; or
- am not employed by the Commonwealth, by a State or Territory or by a body corporate established for a public purpose by such a law;
and am not entitled to any remuneration or allowance (other than reimbursement of reasonable expenses) in respect of that office, appointment or employment;
- am not an undischarged bankrupt; or
- have not been convicted and am not serving one or more year's term of imprisonment for an offence against the law of the Commonwealth or of a State or Territory.

You must include the following with your nomination form:

The nomination deposit of \$500. Payment made in cash or by electronic transfer by calling 1800 698 683.

A recent photograph of you (see the candidate handbook for photograph specifications).

You must ensure the nomination form includes the following:

The name, date of birth, enrolled address and signature of not less than six nominators supporting your nomination.

Your completed and signed consent to stand, any request regarding the form of your name to appear on the ballot paper and your declaration of eligibility.
