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Declaration

I declare that I am qualified under Part III, Division 2 of the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* to be a candidate for election as a member of the Legislative Assembly as I:

- am an Australian citizen;
- have reached the age of 18 years;
- am entitled, or am qualified to become entitled, to vote at elections of members of the Legislative Assembly; and
- have resided within the Commonwealth for at least six months and within the Territory for at least three months.

I also declare that I:

- do not hold an office or appointment (other than a prescribed office or appointment) under a law of the Commonwealth or a law of a State or Territory; or
- am not employed by the Commonwealth, by a State or Territory or by a body corporate established for a public purpose by such a law; and am not entitled to any remuneration or allowance (other than reimbursement of reasonable expenses) in respect of that office, appointment or employment;
- am not an undischarged bankrupt; or
- have not been convicted and am not serving one or more year's term of imprisonment for an offence against the law of the Commonwealth or of a State or Territory.

Note: The onus is on the prospective candidate to ensure she/he is eligible before making the above declaration. It is an offence to provide false and misleading information (Electoral Act s287).

Each nomination must be accompanied by:

- The \$500 nomination deposit (for each endorsed candidate). Payment made in cash or by electronic transfer by calling 1800 698 683.
- A recent photograph of each candidate (see the candidate handbook for photograph specifications).

You must ensure the nomination form includes the following:

- A list of the persons endorsed as candidates by the party; including, the division adjacent to their name.
- A signed consent to stand, which includes any request regarding the form of their name to appear on the ballot paper and their individual declaration of eligibility.
