6. Offences relating to postal ballot papers - Acknowledgement *

I acknowledge the *Electoral Act 2004 (NT)* includes offence provisions relating to postal ballot papers including (but not limited to):

- A person must not unlawfully induce or persuade a person to apply for a postal vote application
- A person who is not an authorised officer must not open a declaration envelope where a postal ballot paper has been placed
- A person who accepts a completed postal ballot paper for sending to the NT Electoral Commission must immediately post or deliver it to the NT Electoral Commission

Privacy

The NT Electoral Commission respects and is committed to safeguarding the confidentiality and privacy of the information that it collects and handles, in accordance with the *Information Act 2002 (NT)*.

You will be asked to provide personal information necessary for us to complete your postal vote request. You do not need to provide your personal information but if you choose not to, you will not receive a postal vote and will be required to vote in person.

The information you provide will be accessible to the NT Electoral Commission your personal details will not be disclosed to third parties unless:

- authorised or required by law to do so
- you have given us your consent to share your personal information for a specific purpose.

You may request access to the personal information we hold about you. If you want more information about the Northern Territory's privacy laws, please refer to the *Northern Territory Information Act 2002*, or the Office of the Information Commissioner NT.

When is the latest I can apply for a postal vote?

Legislative Assembly elections Section 62, <i>Electoral Act 2004</i>	Local government council elections Regulation 28(5), Local Government (Electoral) Regulations 2021
Overseas – application must be received before 5.00pm, 4 days before election day	Overseas – application must be received before 6.00pm, on the 4 days before election day
Within Australia – application must be received before 5.00pm, 2 days before election day	Within Australia – application must be received before 6.00pm on the 2 days before election day.

Note: The election timetable for each election event is published on the NTEC website and will provide the dates when postal vote applications open and close.
