

NAMATJIRA

Namatjira has 6,595 enrolled electors as at 1 May 2024.

- 5,728 enrolled electors at close of roll

2016 Territory Election data

- 5,435 enrolled electors at close of roll
- 3,171 total votes counted
- 58.3% turnout rate by number of votes counted

Observations

Namatjira had a high informality vote at the 2020 Territory Election with 180 informal votes (4.9% of total), with a fairly even split between intentional (51.1%) and unintentional (48.9%) informality.

There was an increase of voters from 2016 to 2020 by 5.4% (293 voters) and following the full distribution of preferences the final margin for Namatjira was 22 votes.

Location

The division of Namatjira covers the south eastern corner of the Northern Territory. It is bounded by the Queensland and South Australian borders on two sides, part of Stuart Highway to its west, and expands just north of the Plenty Highway in its north.

It is a hybrid division that comprises both urban and remote areas. It includes the Alice Springs suburbs of Arumbera, Connellan, Ilparpa, Irlpme, Kilgariff, Larapinta, Mount Johns, (most of) Stuart, Undoolya, and White Gums. The division also includes the communities of Amoonguna, Atitjere (Harts Range), Finke, Santa Teresa, and Titjikala.
